- How do you think David reacted when Nathan announced that instead of David building God a house, God would be building David a house or lineage?
- What do we learn about God from this passage?
- Who was more surprised in these two stories, David or Mary? Why?
- Why is part of the Christmas message that nothing is impossible for God?
- Imagine salvation is like a house. Where are you in relationship to the house? Still outside? On the porch about to come in? In the doorway? In the hallway headed deeper in the house? In the living room by the fire? In an upstairs bedroom?
- What are your hopes for this Christmas?

Holy God who is active and moving among us, we continue to be surprised at how you are concerned for us. Give us the eyes of faith that we might be surprised by your presence the ways you are working within us and within our world this Christmas. Amen.

The Lord will exult over you with loud singing. Let us pray: God of hope, God of peace, God of joy, and God of love, teach us how to love one another as reflections of your light in the world.

All: God of promise, God of love, into our darkness come. Amen.
