Read: John 20:19-31

This passage is dense with concepts and ideas (forgiveness; how does the risen Christ walk through doors or walls?; the relationship between believing and seeing, and so on). Write out the questions that surface for you in this passage. Find answers to them.

Can you identify with Thomas's skepticism about the disciples' claim (v. 25)? Why or why not?

Some have referred to the modern American culture as an age of skepticism. Do you think that is accurate? How might that influence some people's reluctance to share the good news?

What one sign (v. 30) would you wish to see that might strengthen your belief?

How does our faith grow in times when we don't "see" God's presence around us?

Merciful God, we are amazed that almighty God would come and live among us. Dying and rising from the grave seems almost impossible to comprehend. We give you thanks that you are beyond our imaginations, for if we could understand you, you would be only as large as our imaginations.
